

NOTICE TO HUNTERS

The Mesgi'g Ugju's'n wind farm team informs hunters that regular construction work at the wind farm will be suspended for the moose rifle hunting season, which runs from OCTOBER 15 TO 23 INCLUSIVELY. However, work will continue on commissioning the wind turbines and construction of the operations and maintenance building. No work requiring heavy machinery or blasting will be authorized during that week.

The wind turbines commissioning requires

- Teams of three workers travelling by van
- Work inside the wind turbines
- Work inside the Operations & Maintenance building

WORK SCHEDULE

To make the season as successful as possible, we will also be reducing **work hours**. These will run from **9:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.** for moose hunting week.


To minimize disruptions to hunting, we will also **limit our travel** in the park between **3 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.**

SECURITY MEASURES

Since emergency services must be able to access the wind farm installations at all times, we ask that you please free up roadways for safety reasons and avoid setting up camp within 400 m of a wind turbine. We also ask you to remain vigilant and to respect speed limits. Security guards will be travelling along the construction site at any time.

These special measures, adopted by the Liaison Committee, are intended to help you practice your sport with as few constraints as possible on our end.
