This report is a brief and accurate summary of the Medicinal plants diversity found in the wind farm area. It was based on the study (Migmaq Medicinal Medicines) a collection of 72 known variety of plants used by natives.

To validate our sampling method, we have collected the information using the *Medicinal Plant Field Survey Protocol, Mesgi'g Ugiu'u'n Project*.

Mrs. Emmanuel Gendron selected 30 windmill sites and 14 wet land areas based on this protocol, aerial pictures and personal knowledge.

The information and pictures were gathered during the period going from October 6 to October 10 2014 by a team made of Emanuel Gendron, Scott Metalique, Charle Rathie and Jean Bélanger.

The timing for this venture was not at its best, there was some plants that were in dormant stage and the identification was very difficult , however, thanks to the knowledge of Mrs. Gendron most of them were successfully identified.

The diversity of plants was absent and the varieties identified were classified as common plants on most sites.

Flood line area and humid soil were the areas with the most species that were again very common species that bared no particular significance for the present study.

There was some area where moose fed on maple and paper birch, but there was more area for them not far from the selected area.

To summarize, there is no medicinal plant species at risk or lack of them, in the area surveyed.
